ORDINANCE NO. 1.

Ordinance Prohibiting Offences and Disorderly Conduct and Providing a Penalty Therefore.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Boardman, Section 1.

No person or persons shall within the corporate Bests of the city of Boardman, he gulle of any violent, riotous or disorded coaduct, or shall use any professe, sousive or obscene language in any street, house or place whereby the peace or quiet of any person or persons is or may be disturbed, or be guilty of any indecent or immoral conduct or prac-

Section II.

No person or persons shall within the corporate limits of the city of Boardman, willfully drive or ride any horse or mule or other animal upon any sidewalk or drive or ride any horse, mule or other animal through any streets or place at a greater speed than six (6) miles

Section III.

No person or persons shall within the corporate limits of the city of Boardman willfully drive an automobile at a greater speed than twenty (20) miles per hour, and at intersections and school houses not to exceed twelve (12) miles por hour, and in no case at a rate of speed that will endanger the properly of another, or the life and limb of any

Section IV. No person or persons shall within he corporate limits of the city of Boardman discharge or fire any pistol, gun, rifle or any other fire arms. Section V.

No person or persons shall within the corporate limits of the city of Boardman be guilty of any assault or assault and battery upon any person or persons. Section VI.

No person or persons shall resist any peace officer within the corporate limits of the city of Boardman, or shall refuse on request or order



Section VII.

No person or persons shall in any manner whatsoever interfere with any property or apparatus, or with member of the fire department of the city of Boardman, while said fire department shall be engaged in practice or active service, or in athydrant through any street, alley private property or public place to the location of a fire, or drive across any hose at any time with any stock wagon, or other vehicle, or other movable property, or in any manner interfere with said fire department, whether visible damage is done to said hose, property or apparatus or not; and the chief of said fire department, his assistants, or any ofjudge as to what is an interference with said property, or liability to damage of any of its property.

Section VIII, Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall city iail not less than one nor more than twenty days, or by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and in both cases increased. shall pay the costs of said trial, or The capacity of the siles at O. Dodd, lord high owner of the site and principal citizen, was in Pendleton Thursday conferring with the court over the proposed new city and had the plat approved by the county surveyor, county assessor and the court.

Automatic Tamper is Used in Filling Silos

An automatic tamper used in filling silos has proved successful at the Oregon Agricultural college. The tamper is the first one used in the state. It is said to increase the capacity of silos packed in the ordinary way 50 per cent.
