Onion Smut Problem Solved by Experiments

Oregon cow testing associations lead all other cow testing associations in the western states for butter fat production during the month of May. It is announced by Professor E. Finn of the college extension service. The 3460 cows tested in this state gave an average yield of 41.6 pounds of butter fat per cow for the month, or 1.34 pounds daily. In the state the Tillamook made the highest yield from an individual cow, with 14.62 pounds of butter fat produced. Three Oregon associations, are now in the 100 per cent pure bred bull class according to the college's records.

Due to the present draught, orchardists who do not have irrigation should take care of the moisture supply. Moisture can be conserved by cultivation by not added to. As long as the dry spell lasts growers are urged to cultivate thoroughly at least once a week as late as the middle to the latter part of August. This will maintain good growing conditions, sizable fruit and prevent the draught spot.

Grass Mixture Advise Green

The experiment station can make the analyses of grass seeds to go into mixtures, advise just how much to use in the mixture and how much of seed. Have the seed tested early.

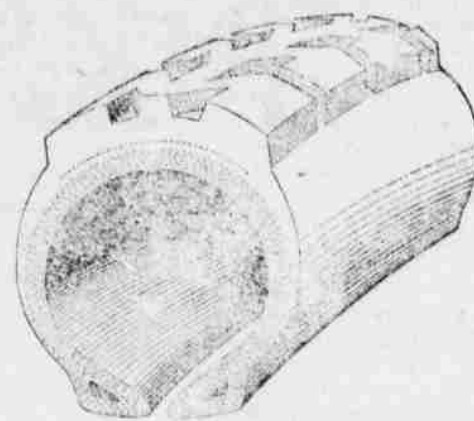
The growth of nursery stock and young trees will be somewhat retarded this year because of the severe dry spell. Anyone wishing to bud trees should plan to do this by the first to the tenth of August depending on variety in order to insure the bark peeling well.

Diseased potato plants cannot be quarantined in the field nor is there a treatment for many field diseases. The sick or diseased plants should be dug out and destroyed.

Walnut Blight Less Severe

Walnut and filbert blight are less severe than last season, due to the late spring and warm dry weather. Both blights are bacterial diseases. No remedy has yet been found for walnut blight. The disease attacks the young filbert trees, affecting the new shoots and suckers. The suckers should be removed as soon as the blight appears. This appears to be a year unfavorable to the development of apple scab.
