FARM POINTERS

(Farm Notes from O. A. C. Experiment Station.)

A source of supply of clover seed for spring planting on fall sown grain should be looked up now. The value of the seed may be determined by having purity and germination tests made on the seed selected. The testing of seed is done free of charge by the state laboratory.

A successful farmer is the one small number one to be set. Chickens who take advantage of the expert-hens are more efficient than turkey eggs of others. Bearing this in mind, the farmer can make the best use

of his time at this season of the year. Losses in crop production from bycatching up on the reading that diseases of wheat, barley, oats, etc., he has neglected during the summer, potatoes, apples and peaches for 1921 in Oregon amounted to \$2,184, 511.75. Farmers should bear this in mind and make careful plans to

Turkey eggs can be successfully that the losses can be reduced to a minimum, but use hens where a minimum.

Clyde G. Hunter, collector of internal revenue, calls the attention of Oregon taxpayers to the fact that without any exception the following persons must file income tax returns for the year not later than March 15:

Every single person who had a net income of \$1,000 or more.

Every married person who had a net income of \$2,000 or more.

Every head of a family who had a net income of \$1,000 or more.

The exemption for a single person is \$1,000; for a married person \$2,000, if his income does not exceed \$5,000. If the net income of a married person exceeds \$5,000, he is allowed an exemption of only \$2,000.

The exemption allowed for dependents under 18 years of age or incapable of self-support is \$400,

but a return must be made in order for the taxpayer to claim credit for the exemption. In other words, a return must be filed, although the taxpayer may not be liable to the payment of a tax after claiming the exemptions to which he is entitled under the law.

Don't forget! March 15 is the final day for filing returns. Taxpayers who fail to file by that time will be liable to heavy penalties.
