MOTHERS HELPED IN BABIES' CARE

Every Saturday at the Sparta building, Medford, from 10 a. m. to 4 p. m. the Jackson county public health nurse will be "on duty" prepared to weigh, measure and record any child under seven years of age. Government literature will be found ready for distribution for any mother who may desire it on the care of the child under seven years of age. Young mothers are especially invited to avail themselves of this public health center, which is for the use of any mother in Jackson county, without any charges connected with this service.

"Keeping children well," is the slogan for future health work in the United States. Many of the mid-western states are employing physicians who are especially trained in children's work to hold "clinics" in different small towns throughout the state. Minnesota is doing splendid work along this line.

Parents are advised as to the care of the growing child and its dietary. The first seven years of the child's life are the important years for physical growing, and these public health centers are established in many towns in many states. The county public health nurse is being utilized as the agent for helping mothers as to the wisest methods for keeping the little fellows well.

It is hoped that the mothers of Jackson county will "line up" with the mothers in other parts of the state of Oregon in freely using the public health center. The rooms are attractively furnished; toys will be found to interest the children; a basket for the babies, and a measuring table for them; a platform scale for the older children.

The standard weight and measurement card (Dr. Emmett Holt) will be given to all mothers who are kept of all children who are brought to the Public Health Centre.
