PORTUGUESE HONOR MEMORY OF PATRON SAINT By William A. Bentley. (U. P. Staff Correspondent) LISBON—(By Mail)—There has just been organized in Lisbon a National Crusade to do honor to the memory of Nun Alvares Pereira and initiate a movement throughout Portugal for celebrating simultaneously on August 14, the anniversary of the battle of Aljubarotta and Nun Alvares' great life work on behalf of the national independence.

No figure in the gallery of medieval chivalry is more winning than that of Nun Alvares Pereira—the "Santo Condestable." A contemporary of the Black Prince, as a brave soldier, a daring and successful general and a type of the perfect and gentle knight, he ranks with the best. The hero of national independence, he figures no less among the saintly and sainted figures of the great age of the church in Europe.

He had, too, the rare fortune to find in the anonymous author of the "Chronics de Condestable," a chronicler worthy his theme. This fine though too-little known old Portuguese chronicle will compare with the very best of the personal chronicles of early European literature—with De Joinville or the "Loyal Serviteur" in French or in Spanish with the chronicles of Alvarez da Luna or of Pedro Nino. Though among the very best of the old Portuguese classics, the editions of it have been few, and the book is not common.
