GOES INSANE OVER DROPPING PRICES AND SLAYS FAMILY

WAYNE, Neb., Nov. 27—Driven insane by the decreasing values of wheat, corn, hogs and other farm products and feeling he would be unable to meet his financial obligations, George H. Dinkle, aged 32, farmer, ten miles southwest of here, killed his wife and two children, mortally wounded two others and then committed suicide by cutting his throat and hanging himself.

The wife, 26, daughter Ella, 3 and son Glenn, 4, had their heads split open with a hatchet. The son Glenn had later been hanged to a rafter in the barn where the body of the father was found.

Another daughter, Edna, 2, and a baby boy, one year old, are alive, though expected to die from wounds inflicted in the head with a hatchet.
