MANY MOVIE HOUSES STARTED BY SOVIET. NEW YORK, July 7.—Trains equipped with motion picture machines and films are being run through Siberia, giving exhibitions at each railroad station, according to Julius Kohner, Czechoslovakian cinema authority and publisher of "Filmschau," one of the best known international trade journals, just arriving in this country.

The Soviet government is strongly in favor of the development of motion pictures and is paying great attention to the community effects of "movie" theatres, he says. The Lenin-Trotsky government has encouraged the erection of picture palaces, which are operated by a commission of the Soviet government.

Comply With the Law AND USE Printed Butter Wrappers. ACCORDING to the ruling of the Oregon Dairy and Food Commission all dairy butter sold or exposed for sale in this state must be wrapped in butter paper upon which is printed the words "Oregon Dairy Butter, 16 (or 32) ounces full weight," with the name and address of the maker.
