According to the new chairman, A. D. Lasker, the shipping board went through \$680,000,000 for the year ending June 30, 1921. And now the board is asking \$300,000,000 as a deficiency appropriation.

Lasker says the total expeditures of the board are hard to estimate due to "the deplorable state of the books which, if kept for the specific purpose of cloaking fraud could not have been better. One thing is cerain, there was an absolute deception of congress and the people on the expenditures of the shipping board." As an instance of the way records were kept, Chairman Lasker points out that "there are 6000 voyages on which no report has ever been made, thanks to the old system of running this gigantic fleet."


