REDUCED WESTBOUND EXPORT RATES TO TAKE EFFECT SEPTEMBER 1.

TO INCREASE EXPORT SHIPMENTS TO ASIA

WILL REVIVE BUSINESS OF PA-CIFIC COAST EXPORT HOUSES TO ORIENT.

PORTLAND, Aug. 15 .- In addition to the reductions in import rates announced by the Southern Pacific company Friday, G. W. Luce, freight traffic manager for the company, states that railroad lines east of Chicago and north of the Ohio and Potomac rivers have also concurred in the publication of reduced westbound export rates. These reductions will take effect September

This means, according to Luce. a revival in export tonnage via Pacific coast ports to Asiastic points which has heretofore moved through the port of New York. The reductions range from 61/2 cents to \$2.90 per 100 pounds and will be of ma- HUU terial benefit to Pacific coast exporters in bringing back to them the business they have formerly enjoyed, but lost to the New York exporter on account of lower charges prevailing from middle west points to the orient by way of New York and the Panama dinal than via Pacific coast ports. GAS COMPANY SOLD TO S. F.

At a receiver's sale of the Oregon Gas and Electric company Saturday the property was bought by the Anglo-California Trust company of San Francisco, Calif., for \$55,555 .-50. The bondholders were represented by Thos. D. Petch, receiver. and the trust company by its vicepresident and cashier, Louis Sutter. There were no other bids.

The sale includes the land and equipment of the gas company in this city, Medford, Grants Pass and Roseburg. This includes 42 acres just south of Medford, 11/2 acres each at Grants Pass and Roseburg. The company's affairs have been in litigation for a year and the sale is expected to straighten them out.

The future plans of the company will not be made public until after a conference to be held at San Francisco this week.
