



The discovery attracted considerable attention among those seeking new deposits of cobalt. But owing Investigate Our Ideal to the low price and less extensive use of the metal at that time, investors were seeking deposits that would produce at least 6 per cent cobalt. Recently, however, operators have been urged to search for new deposits of cobalt, and the deposits of this section have been investigated. Development of the quicksilver properties shows that the cinnabar ore, besides producing gold and silver, nickel, zinc and arsenic. as by-products, also gives evidence of cobalt values. Other localities in this region are believed to contain cobalt in commercial quantities, but the Chisholm mine is the only property in the district which has been reliably and systematically tested

The Chisholm mine is in a heavily timbered district, at an elevation of 1760 feet. About \$45,000 has been spent in its development. In part, the ore is a primary constituent of the norite country rock, and the vein deposits were probably derived from the same source. That is, magmatic waters, after concentration through crystallization of the main magma, probably carried the ores, simultaneously concentrated, into fissures, and there deposited them with other vein-forming matter. At this mine there is no evidence that surface waters have produced any important effects; the veins are not leached or oxidized, and there is no indication of secondary enrichment by

A cross-cut entry extends south 45 egrees, east about 30 feet, and is being driven thence south 63 degrees east about 300 feet through quartzitic rock, but has not ret struck the main ore body at fault. About 150 feet from the portal a fault strikes north 31 degrees west and dips 55 degrees northeast It has a maximum thickness of 18 inches and contains fragments of quartzite. Near the fault the country rock changes from micaceous to an ordinary quartzite. There are two other older adits which show large bodies of ore. The lower and southern entry is in macaceous quartzite banded and locally contorted. The upper adit is about 190 feet higher.
