Hardin County, 'Way Down in Egypt Land

ELIZABETHTOWN, ILL.—Travelers accustomed to the monotony of the flat expanse of level prairie land in northern and central Illinois find it hard to believe they are still in the same state when they invade Hardin county in this corner of "Egypt," as southern Illinois is called. A bit of rugged scenery has been set down in this isolated corner, framed by the great bend of the Ohio river. The hills, which stretch back forty miles from the river, are a continuation of the Ozarks, extending east through Missouri and southern Iffinois.
