

your purpose very satisfactorily. Fruit Bread.-Sift together one cupful of flour, one and one-fourth cupfuls of graham flour, one tablespoonful of sugar, four teaspoonfuls of baking powder, one teaspoonful of salt. Add five tablespoonfuls of shortening, beat two eggs until light; add one cupful of milk and one-fourth of a cupful of molasses. Stir into the dry mixture and add three-fourths of a cupful of chopped figs, one-fourth of a cupful of chopped dates and six prunes chopped fine. Pour into a well-greased bread pan, and let stand 30 minutes. Bake in a moderate oven 40 minutes. Let stand 24 hours before using. Onefourth of a cupful of nuts may be added if desired

Prune Stuffing for Goose,-Mix two cupfuls of stale bread crumbs with two-thirds of a cupful of melted shortening, one teaspoonful of salt, oneeighth of a teaspoonful of pepper and one and one-half teaspoonfuls of sage. Add one apple peeled and chopped and one cupful of stewed, drained, stoned and chopped prunes. Moisten with prune juice and use for filling the

Jellied Prune Whip .- Wash and cover with cold water one-half pound of prunes, and simmer slowly until ten- and at every conceivable angle. der. Add one-half cupful of sugar and simmer five minutes longer. Drain, saving the juice; remove the stones and cut the prunes into very small pieces. Soak two tablespoonfuls of gelatine in one-fourth of a cupful of into the hot prune juice. Add the juice of one large lemon, and cool until beto thicken, then whip until light and foamy. Fold in the prunes and the stiffly beaten whites of two eggs. Pour into a mold or serving dish
