HOW to know apple trees by their leaves, and not alone by their fruit, bids fair to become part of the business of the successful orchardist as a result of seven year's research by the experimental station of the Massachusetts Agricultural college at Amherst. Systematic study of the leaf characters of young apple trees conducted by Dr. J. K. Shaw, expert pomologist, has enabled him to announce a new method of identifying nursery stock that promises to remove one of the most serious risks of fruit growing.
"For no one who has not purchased and set out a block of trees labeled 'McIntosh,' only to find eight years later that the supposed McIntosh trees were all Wolf river, a variety almost worthless in New England, can appreciate what it means to the fruit grower to have the uncertainty removed from the purchase of his nursery stock," says a statement issued from the experiment station.
This fall, with the support of the Massachusetts Fruit Growers' association, Dr. Shaw applied his identification method to 3,000 apple trees in nurseries in this state. To the amazement of the nursery men, he threw out nearly 10 per cent of the young trees for masquerading under a false name.
Dr. Shaw's investigation involved study of leaves of 200 varieties of apple trees collected from orchards of distant states as well as in New England. He discovered that always there were certain characteristics invariable in leaves of the same variety and a great many points of difference between leaves of different varieties.
During his years of research, he applied his leaf tests to 1,100 young apple trees as he set them in his own experimental plots. Only one tree turned out, when it came into bearing, to be different from his marking.
Dr. Shaw does not pretend that anybody can identify fruit trees by their leaves. But study, he says, will enable the fruit grower to distinguish any given variety in the nursery.

MEXIA, TEXAS.—This oil town and the oil country surrounding it have been placed under martial law recently by Governor Neff, because of the existence of open, flagrant violation of the law. Many arrests were made and a quantity of liquor seized.
The situation is in charge of Brig. Gen. Jacob Wolters of the National Guard. Enroute to the area there were forty men of the headquarters troop, Fifty-sixth cavalry brigade. They will be used, General Wolters said, for picket duty and to guard prisoners while the state rangers are conducting investigations of conditions and making arrests.

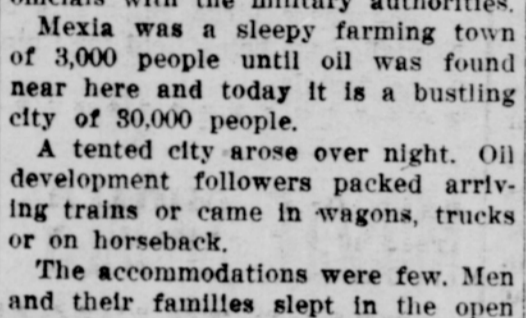

Capper Lists Benefits to Farmer from Solons

By SENATOR ARTHUR CAPPER of Kansas, a Leader of the Senate "Agricultural Bloc"
(Written Expressly for the International News Service)
WASHINGTON, D. C., March 1.—The outstanding achievement in this congress in constructive legislation has been its great work for agriculture. It has laid a new and firm foundation for national prosperity. No doubt mistakes have been made, and there is a great deal yet to be done, but no like amount of important legislation beneficial to the farming industry and therefore to the national welfare, has, in my estimation, ever been accomplished by any preceding congress in such a short time.
President Harding's sympathetic attitude toward the farmer and stock man has been of great help. When the new president and the new congress took up the reins in Washington last March the farming industry was on the verge of collapse. While the crisis has not as yet been passed, the emergency could scarcely have been more promptly met by legislation. As a result we have these new laws for the rehabilitation of the farming industry, several of them epochal and others yet to come.
They are:
The billion-dollar farm export credit measure.
Grains Exchanges Regulated
The Capper-Tincher future trading bill for the regulation of the thirteen great grain exchanges by a board comprising the secretary of agriculture, the secretary of commerce, and the attorney general.
The act placing the control of the packing industry and stockyards under supervision of the secretary of agriculture.
The agricultural emergency tariff bill, which undoubtedly is helping farmers at this moment.
The Kenyon bill, increasing the interest rate on bonds of the farm loan banks from 5 to 5 1/2 per cent, with no increase in the loan rate to farmers. Making it possible to sell these bonds in competition with other securities.
The Curtis bill, appropriating \$25,000,000 as a revolving fund for the federal farm loan banks.
Some Taxation Removed
Some of the burdens of taxation have been removed from the shoulders of farmers by the new revenue law. The exemption for a married man has been raised from \$2000 to \$2500, and the exemption for a dependent has been increased from \$200 to \$400. The wealthy corporations and individuals, who sought to shift more of the burden of war taxes to the shoulders of those least able to pay, did not succeed. Congress refused to cut radically the rate on big incomes, holding that

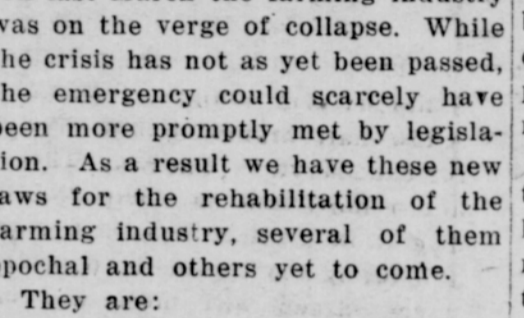

the greater the income the more able the recipient is to pay a bigger tax. Under the new tax law 2,000,000 little homes in the United States will immediately be relieved from further payment of any income taxes. Thousands of other families of small means will receive a reduction of 50 per cent in their income tax rate, instead of reducing the maximum surtax on big incomes from 65 to 32 per cent, as demanded by big business. Congress set the high limit at 58 per cent.
Saving from Armament
Out of the conference on disarmament, called by President Harding will come a saving of billions of dollars, which will help every nation to climb back from the financial and economic depths into which it fell during the world war.
This programme for bettering the economic conditions of the farming industry and putting it on an equal footing with organized industry and business, and reducing the burdens of taxation, has met with bitter opposition from Wall Street business men and eastern newspapers.
But, I believe that the administration fully realizes that the farmer has been made the goat, and that he must be given a square deal if he is to come back and make his vital contribution to the prosperity of the nation.
