HOLDS KLAMATH MORALS ARE ABASED

SALEM, Or., March 7.—C. C. Brower, district attorney for Klamath county, in a letter to Governor Olcott under date of February 18, complained of conditions there which he termed "intolerable" and "damnable" and which he intimated threatened the young people with degradation. The letter was written at the time of the resignation of Circuit Judge Kuykendall, and said further that the lawless element was attempting to have a lawless man appointed chief arbiter.

Governor Olcott in reply says it is his understanding that the district attorney is charged with a large part of the responsibility for moral conditions, and confesses surprise that a complaint of this kind should come from such an official.

NEW HOSPITAL WING TO BE READY JUNE 1

PENDLETON, Or., March 7.—The new wing of the Eastern Oregon state hospital will probably be ready for occupancy about June 1, according to Dr. W. D. McNary, superintendent, who says that because of weather conditions, the work has suffered about six weeks' delay.

The framework of reinforced concrete, is completed with the exception of the exterior finish, in stucco effect. The plumbing and heating systems are being installed.

The wing, three stories and a basement, will cost \$145,000, and will provide quarters for 180 patients, bringing the capacity of the hospital up to 740. Hilmar J. Fettergren has the contract.
