




## NATIONALIZE COAL MINES ONLY REMEDY SAYS LEWIS

WASHINGTON, April 3 .- "Sooner or later the government must step in and nationalize the coal mines and operate them for the benefit of the public, and it might as well be now as any time."

This was the message of advice laid before congress by President Lewis of the United Mine Workers of America, when he appeared before the house labor committee today to present the miners' side of the present strike controversy.

The striking miners, Lewis said, are going to "stand pat," and present an unbroken front. He advised the committee to attempt to force an agreement through boards of arbitration.


