court's decision can be delayed until a permanent plan is adopted by the interstate commarce commission for **CELEBRATE!** the zoning of the systems in western Oregon, the development of the territory will likely continue.

The supreme court left the plan of applying its decision for the disruption of the properties to the United States district court which originally heard the case. It is very important to western Oregon that the plan of dissolution of the properties be allowed to conform to the act of 1920 now being worked out by the interstate commerce commission. This materially effects the immediate future development and prosperity of western Oregon, and the chambers of commerce of this section should get busy to see if there is anything they can do to bring it about.






