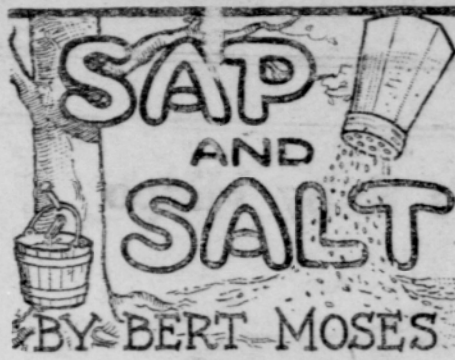
See where they got 40 baseball gamblers in Chicago the other day. A little too early for another world's series scandal—and besides nothing has been heard of Abe Attell for quite a while.
