

How to Combat Garden Pests

The excessive drougth and hot days of this summer are particularly favorable to the development of insect pests. The red spiders are especially serious on beans, cane fruits may suffer serious injury. Sulphur in some form is the standard insecticide for the red spider. For limited areas, dust sulphur, using if possible superfine dusting sulphur, will prove the easiest and most ractical treatment. For hops, fruit trees, etc., where liquid sprays are being applied, self-boiled lime-sulphur, "atomic sulphur" or very dilute (1-100) lime sulphur may be used.

Use Black Leaf 40 for Thrips Thrips are particularly serious on garden crops, such as beans, broccoli and onions. Black leaf 40 and soap or kerosene emulsion as used for aphis control is the st spray for this insect pest.
