PORTLAND RAISES FUNDS FOR ASTORIA

PORTLAND, Dec. 12.—Forty thousand dollars of a fund of \$50,000 was raised by Portland business men at noon today for Astoria relief.

Two hundred pairs of gloves were rushed there to take care of the guards and relief workers, who were suffering from the penetrating cold.

MORE THAN 4000 WARDS NOW IN 11 INSTITUTIONS

SALEM, Dec. 12.—A total of 4203 wards are in the state's 11 educational, eleemosynary and penal institutions, whose maintenance is costing the state approximately \$1,150,000 annually.

The present population of these institutions shows a substantial increase during eight years, the average daily population for the biennium of 1913-1914 being 2895, with the annual maintenance approximating \$587,500.

These figures do not take into consideration the more than 800 orphanages, foundlings, wayward girls and other wards of private charitable institutions toward whose support the state contributes more than \$125,000 annually.
