### SALE OF STRAHORN ROAD IS DENIED IN TELEGRAM

KLAMATH FALLS, Dec. 23.—Denial that negotiations are under way for sale of the Oregon, California & Eastern railroad, rumored following the purchase by S. O. Johnson of a mill site adjoining Klamath Falls on the south, was contained in a telegram received here by W. F. Bond, superintendent of the railroad from Robert E. Strahorn, who is now in New York City.

Strahorn declared that the road will be built according to his original plans, "being headed straight for Bend, and destined consistently to develop all of central Oregon."
