

Business men can get vastly more out of a printer than a low bid, and it is reasonably certain that they can get less from the lowest bidder than even the low price calls for; because while he may find it necessary to sell his product at a low price, his dilemma forces him to strike as hard a bargain in delivery as his customer does in buying.

Choose a good printer; he can help you build a better business if you will let him.
