SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 15.—The extent to which transportation is becoming motorized in California is shown by the annual report of the automobile department of the California Railroad Commission.

This report shows that there are 713 motor carriers operating under the jurisdiction of the Commission and they employ 1600 cars in passenger service and nearly 1500 trucks and trailers for freight carrying. During the last calendar year the auto carriers of the State transported 21,221,928 passengers.

Under the regulation of the Commission this form of transportation is rapidly becoming standardized and a higher class of service rendered each year. So rapidly has been the development of this form of transportation that it is now possible to travel by auto in California from the Oregon line to the Mexican border, choice of valley or coast route being offered. Across-the-State service is given in the extreme north, it being possible to travel by auto using several different stage lines from Crescent City to Fort Bidwell, from Eureka to Red Bluff, to Nevada State line; from Orville, Calif., Sacramento and Stockton to the Lake Tahoe and Feather River territory; from the center of population to the Yosemite Valley and contiguous territory; from Fresno and Bakersfield and other Valley points to the Coast and to the high Sierras.

Out of Los Angeles and San Diego stage lines run in every direction, serving San Bernardino Mountain territory, Imperial Valley, and the vast desert areas that spread over the southeastern part of the State. Many of the stage lines publish joint tariffs and so arrange their time schedules that the necessary change from one line to another is accompanied by a minimum of discomfort. As a result there are few places in California today that are inaccessible to the traveler by auto

The Campbelle, one of the landmarks of the campus of the University of California at Berkeley, is one of the world's few earthquake proof structures, according to professors in the engineering department of the university. It was built in imitation of the famous Italian tower. At the time it was built there was a great deal of discussion as to the practicability of shock-proof buildings. The professor contended that such a tower could be built which would be successful, and others said that it could not. Finally the professors won, and the tower was built as they wished it.

In order to maintain the proper balance of the structure, so as to keep it from falling when an earthquake comes, the walls were made thicker at the bottom. As the walls rise the thickness becomes less, until at the top they are thinner than the average walls. In this way the center of gravity is much lower than it would be if the walls were the same thickness throughout. When an earthquake comes the tower will rock and sway, but it will not fall. It works on the same principle as the always upright salt-shaker, of the toy dolls which cannot be knocked down.

very good for small buildings, or ornamental towers, it is believed that it will not be a success in the business districts, as the space which would be taken up by the thickness of the walls is too valuable to waste in such a manner.

U. S. WILL NOT PROSECUTE SLAYER OF SANDPIPER

PORTLAND, Nov. 15.—Mayhap Embert Wells did shoot a sandpiper that piped on the Tillamook coast but the United States government will not attempt to prove that he did.

Wells was formally charged with slaying the bird and was ordered to appear in the federal district court here Wednesday of this week to answer the charge. Then the prosecution weakened.

"It can't be done, said Assistant United States District Attorney Allen Bynon. "The sandpiper hasn't enough friends to prove that Wells killed him." Judge Bean dismissed the case.
