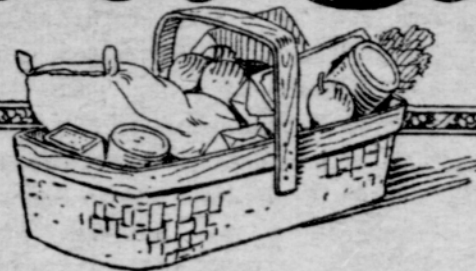

A charming morning frock is pictured to the left. It is a slip-on, developed in dark blue wool crepe and trimmed with the lingeric collar and cuffs that Paris affects so frequently this season. The model is so simple that it may be carried out in a number of fashionable fabrics. If preferred, the upper part of the skirt and lower part of the blouse may be of contrasting material. Medium size requires 3 1/2 yards 36-inch material.

With yoke and front panel cut in one, the second model expresses a new idea for the one-piece slip-on frock. It is suited to development in the season's woollens, silks or satins. The neck may be finished in round or V-shaped outline, or, if preferred, the front may be slashed and the edges turned back to form revers. auditor of the Southern Pacific company, at the decisive fruit rate hearing in San Francisco before examiner E. M. Steer of the Interstate Commerce commission.

In the western district the 18 larger railroads in 1922 had an operating income of \$287,891,000 which provided a return of 3.71 per cent on their property. During this year the return has been at the rate of 3.75 per cent according to testimony by Adams.

Five of the large railroads in the eastern group have earned this year a return of 4.99 per cent on their property the witness testified. Exhibits presented by the witness showed the net of return for the 23 railroads listed from both territories to be an average of 4.22 per cent for this year. An exhibit showing the number of railroad employees, hours worked and compensation for 1915 and for 1922 was introduced. This compilation showed an increase in rate of wages of all employees in 1922 to be 123 per cent as compared with 1915.

Another tabulation showed a comparison of railway tax accrues from 1916 to 1922, inclusive and

for the first nine months of 1923. This showed a total tax for the 23 railroads of \$60,501,109 and in 1922 of \$191,822,953, an increase of over 217 per cent.

L. N. Wetlong, representing the western railroads, testified at length concerning governmental and railroad reports showing transportation costs and the prosperity of the farmers generally. He gave estimated costs for handling California products to eastern markets.

The hearing is being conducted on the application of the California deciduous fruit shippers to the commission for a reduction from

\$1.73 to \$1.44 in the rate on this class of fruits from California to Atlantic Coast states.
