## RELIEF IN SIGHT FOR VICTIMS OF HAY FEVER

O. A. C. Botanical Department  
Plans Inoculation to Ward Off Malady.

CORVALLIS, Ore., March 5.—Is there relief in sight for the many chronic sufferers of hay fever?

The Oregon Agriculture college department believes so. Pollens are being prepared and persons subject to the ailment will be inoculated with a prepared solution before the pollens of plants appear in the spring.

Pollens carried by the wind and not those carried by insects are the common ones which give hay fever, according to Dr. Helen M. Gilkey, assistant professor of botany at the college. The most inconspicuous pollens, such as velvet grass and pigweed, are usually the most dangerous, Dr. Gilkey stated.

The pollen test is given by applying a small portion of the solution to a wound scratched on the arm or the back of the hand. If the wound becomes infected it indicates that the person is subject to hay fever when coming in contact with the particular pollen.

The person affected by a pollen is treated to a series of inoculations which make him develop a resistance against the particular kind of pollen.

**PROPERTY VALUED AT \$4,000,000 IS SEIZED**

Report to Commissioner Haynes Shows Activity of Nation's Dry Forces.

WASHINGTON, Mar. 6.—A report covering the activities of the General Agents' Force during the past fiscal year, submitted to Commissioner Haynes, shows great activity on the part of the dry forces. According to the report, property seized during the year totaled in value nearly four millions dollars. These seizures do not include the activities of agents operating under state directors.

In addition to articles used in the manufacture of illicit liquor, such as fermenters, barrels, kegs,

automobiles, 57 motor boats and launches, 29 horses and mules, 15 wagons, buggies and sleighs, 2 sets of harness, of which the total appraised value was \$3,816,524.77, while the expense incident to seizure was only \$5,269.16.
