SMALL GOES ON "TRIAL" NEXT MONTH

Constituents Will Be Asked to Affirm or Renounce Court's Decision.

PRIMARY FIGHT BITTER

"Smallism" Made Main Issue of Campaign; Governor in Fiery Denials.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., March 27. —Governor Len Small, acquitted in court of making missteps with state funds, will, in effect, go on trial before the people of Illinois April 8. In the primary election that day the republican voters of the state will render their verdict on whether the governor is the man his enemies charge or whether he is a persecuted citizen, deserving of another term as chief executive.
