DAUGHERTY'S RESIGNATION BRINGS RELIEF

The announcement yesterday of the news of the resignation of Attorney General Daugherty brings relief from a situation that has been decidedly embarrassing, and brings to an end a situation that called forth bitter criticism of the administration from those of all political faiths.

The deposed Daugherty was made the subject of attacks from the day his appointment to the head of the department of justice was announced. The late President Harding was criticized for naming Daugherty to the responsible position. As time wore on the incompetency and undesirability of the man became all the more apparent. At the time Colidge succeeded to the presidency hopes were high that in considering his cabinet that he would rid the government of Daugherty, but it required startling revelations of graft, intrigue, interference with law enforcement, and corruption of the most sordid kind to bring an end to his official career.
