The outstanding fact is that our national-convention system has broken down and that some new system must be devised if we are to continue to have coherent politics in this country.

"Even the seemingly orderly procedures of Senator La Follette, in his project of running as an independent, are open to none but men with national reputation like La Follette, and it will be discovered that the processes of placing La Follette's name on the ballots in this country, as an independent candidate, will cost a very large amount of money.

"What we have now is the ratification convention, like the one at Cleveland, which is no convention at all, and is simply a rubber stamp, or the rigidly ruled and absolutely precedented convention, like the one at New

York, which is not a convention, either, and is a rabble. "Neither is a deliberative assembly. Neither is representative of anything but machine politics of one sort or another. Neither has any popular feature."
