**BOAT SINKS, RUINS BIG TRIP TO ARCTIC**

PORTLAND, Oct. 22.—Property valued in excess of \$7500 stolen from local stores by the theft ring now under investigation, was recovered by the police yesterday and through lack of space in the police property rooms, was stored in a warehouse until the courts release it to its owners.

No arrests were made yesterday in connection with the operations of Frank Taylor, H. C. Banfield and Willard Oakes, the alleged ringleaders of the gang now held in jail. The police moved cautiously, merchants and business men were not willing to swear to complaints unless positive evidence of dishonesty was forthcoming, so the police spent the day clearing a number of local homes of household goods, furniture and art objects said to have been furnished by members

of the ring. Detective Hellyer, in charge of the investigation, spent the greater part of the day with a moving van, collecting stolen furniture from homes and hiding places about the city. Detective Mallet, co-operating with him, again raid-

ed "The Tapestry Shoppe" at Milwaukee and recovered about \$500 worth of silks and tapestries, a valuable silver set and a mahogany tea wagon which Oakes and the two interior decorators admitted had been stolen from local stores.

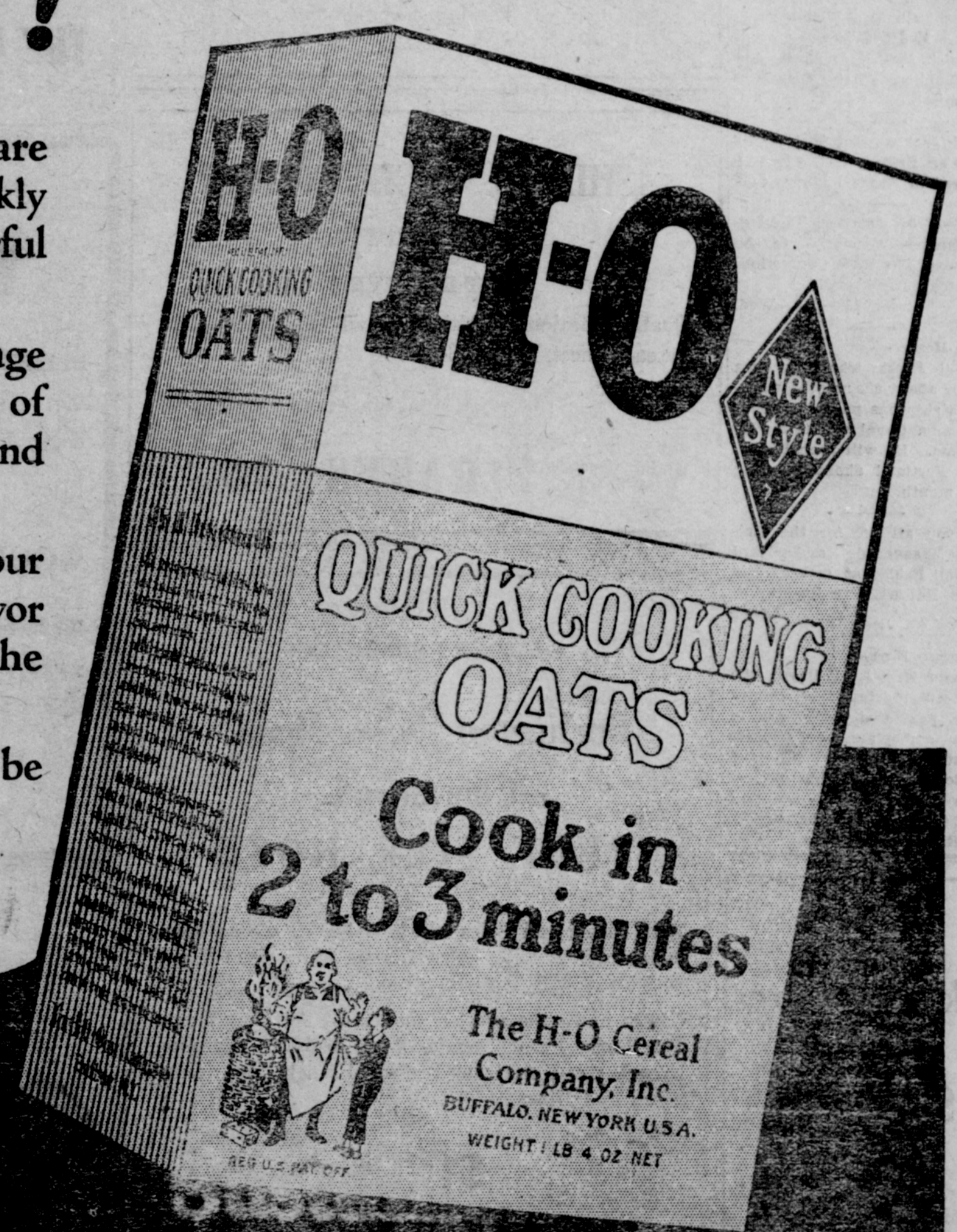
