berries, and vegetables. The Ashland district especially is adapted to the production of small fruits and vegetables, and such large fruits as peaches and apples and pears. All of these products have broad possible markets in the surrounding timber and mining and stockraising regions, and many new settlers are needed to farm these new lands.

The distribution of these products is a marketing problem and in this work the marketing department of the Portland chamber of commerce is anxious to cooperate. This department already has helped in standardizing such Oregon products as prunes, eggs, cranberries, and walnuts. It also is aiding plans for standardizing the cannery and the dairy products of the state. Oregon surplusers are urged to contact the marketing department of the Portland chamber of commerce.
