**U. S. FAST LOSING ROLE AS LEADING COTTON EXPORTER**  
CHICAGO, Nov. 25. — The United States, as the world's greatest country, is losing that distinction, according to the Sears-Robuck Agricultural Foundation, in Chicago.  
Of the 2,708,000 bales of cotton imported by England from all ports last year 1,400,000 came from the United States, 729,000 from Egypt, 44,000 from Brazil and 535,000 from other countries, principally India and Peru. In the period from 1909 to 1913 England got three-fourths of her cotton from America. Last year's percentage shows but a little more than one-half coming from this country.  
Representatives of English cotton manufacturers state that unless the United States can furnish more cotton at a cheaper price, more vigorous steps will be taken to supply their needs elsewhere.  
India, according to the Foundation, is the greatest cotton producing country next to the United States, with the possible exception of China, which grows no exportable surplus.  
A newly organized cotton growing corporation is expected to cut in further on our share of the export trade. This corporation, which has contracted for the building of the Sudan Dam, has made arrangements for the construction of a railway in Northern Africa, and is expected to increase African cotton production at least 100,000 bales. Two hundred thousand bales are now grown in sections of Africa outside of Egypt, which normally produces 1,200,000 bales.  
Three methods are advanced by the Agricultural Foundation to prevent the possible dethronement of King Cotton. New and cheaper fertilizers to effect the necessary economies; a united attack to stamp out the bollweevil, or economy coming from improved machinery, and improved farming systems which will provide cotton labor production work the year around, instead of only six to eight months are the three "lifesavers" offered.  
"We might be forced to use a combination of all of them," Foundation experts conclude.

McNabb telegraphed the owner in Chico, and this morning received an answering wire, asking McNabb to state the condition of the automobile, the owner failing to state whether or not he would come to this city to take possession of his car.  
**COOLIDGE URGES CONSERVATION OF TIMBER**  
WASHINGTON, Nov. 25.—Only the most drastic conservation measures, which must be put into effect immediately, will prevent the absolute disappearance of all of America's great forests within a period of less than fifty years. President Coolidge revealed in an address which opened the National Conference on the Utilization of Forest Products.  
The President pointed out the need for the creation of an adequate forest reserve, in order to cope with the cut-off which is taken from the forests every year. The danger of the annihilation of the lumber industry, the third largest industry in the country at the present time, unless some means of re-foresting the cut over lands is started in the near future, was shown by the President. He urged that the members of the Conference co-operate in building up a forest reserve which will prove adequate for future years.  
**Buyers Eagerly Take French Loan Bonds**  
NEW YORK, Nov. 24. — Bonds of the hundred million dollar French Republic loan, offered by the syndicate which is

headed by the J. P. Morgan Company, were eagerly bought off the market today. The demand equalled the heavy buying experienced in the German reconstruction loan offering of two months ago.  
**BROOKHART DECLARED WINNER OF ELECTION**  
DES MOINES, Iowa, Nov. 25.—Senator Smith Brookhart was officially declared to be winner in Iowa's Senatorial race by the executive council of the state today, with 447,706 votes against 446,951 cast for Dan Steck, his democratic rival.  
wellknown German inventor and former associate of Count Zeppelin, has grave doubts as to the feasibility of transatlantic commercial flying by lighter-than-air craft.  
On the other hand, he paints a rosy picture of the future possibilities of travel by heavier-than-air craft, to which he has now turned his attention.  
"It is only a question of a few years before it will be possible to travel generally just as safely by air as by railway, steamer or motor car," Dr. Rohrbach declared in an interview. "To my mind the future in the air lies in the construction of all-metal airplanes and seaplanes."  
"I have turned my attention to the construction of commercial seaplanes made entirely of duralumin. Three such machines are being tested at Copenhagen and will shortly be put on a commercial route, which is as yet being kept secret."  
"The world has not yet realized the potential possibilities of commercial aviation. If the money were forthcoming we could fly machines, with 150-foot wing spread, capable of carrying forty persons, and equipped, if necessary, with dining rooms."  
"Whether or not airplanes will ever be used on the cross-Atlantic route remains to be seen, for it is a big span; but, on the other hand, in the future the journey from London to Copenhagen or to Christiania will be made by seaplane."
