MAN IN THOUSAND WEDS ANOTHER SHY COLLEGE WOMAN

CHICAGO, Jan. 7. — Steady Ralph Obenchain, "the man in a million," refuses to believe that lightning strikes twice in the same place — he has proved it by marrying pretty Mabel Schmitz daughter of a wealthy stock broker.

His bride was the belle of Northwestern University campus — the same spot, where a few years ago, Obenchain, then a young lawyer, wooed and won Madalynne Conner, ruler of collegiate hearts.

Later they were divorced. After a romantic affair with Arthur C. Burch, a professor at the college and a friend of Obenchain, Mrs. Obenchain went to California.

There she and Burch were arrested for the slaying of J. Belmont Kennedy, a wealthy admirer of Mrs. Obenchain. After a sensational trial, in which her husband came to her aid with money and counsel, although on the witness stand she had confessed infidelity to him, the accused were freed.

"Ralph is a man in a million," Mrs. Obenchain told friends. "The woman who gets him is lucky indeed!"

And Ralph Obenchain returned to the scene of his great unhappiness to find that woman.

MUSIC HALLS ARE HIT BY HIGH COST

LONDON, Jan. 7.—High class music hall entertainment is doomed in London because of a dearth of talent and the fact that really first-rate entertainers are able to command much higher salaries in the United States than music hall managers are able to pay them here.

That's the belief of Sir Alfred Butt, who has just announced that the Empire Theatre will revert to "movies" after a five months' trial of high class vaudeville.

"The public is there, but the artists are not," declared Sir Alfred. "I have had agents and representatives searching all over the continent, the United States and this country for performers suitable as star turns for the Empire, and we have found only two — Miss Nora Bayes and Frank Tinney. I have tried to engage a few other artists and turns, but either they would not come to London or else their terms were prohibitive."

"An American comedian asked for \$2,500 a week. I offered an English artist \$3,750 a week if she would come out of her retirement, but the engagement did not materialize."

"There are some artists in America who are the sort of outstanding turns needed at a theatre like the Empire, but very few in this country — two or three at the most."

"We do not breed music hall artists in this country as we used to breed them. The vogue of revue brought young artists under the producer and so killed individual initiative. And many of our best artists have been lured away, quite naturally, by the gigantic salaries offered in the United States."

"One well-known English comedian is being paid \$2,500 a week in New York; another is to go there next year at a salary of \$3,500 a week. We simply cannot compete with that sort of thing."

Butt declared he had lost an enormous amount of money in his five months' venture at the Empire. Several other music halls are still in operation in the West End, but it is understood they are having hard sledding.

SURVIVOR TELLS OF HORROR RIDE ON COWCATCHER

INDIANAPOLIS, Jan. 8.—Declaring that she felt as if she had returned from the "Great Beyond," Mrs. Kenneth Clark, eighteen, who clung for more than twelve miles to the cowcatcher of a locomotive speeding through darkness at the rate of sixty miles an hour, told of her awful experience.
