COW CREEK PROJECT WILL FURNISH PLENTY OF WATER

line which was backed up from Siskiyou Gap to its interception of the Cow Creek sources had been located from fifty to one hundred feet less in elevation a considerably increased volume of water would have been picked up, but this increase in the water supply would not nearly justify the additional tunnel length involved.

Two days, October 6 and 7 were spent in moving the camp equipment from Ashland and establishing camp at a point about a mile southwesterly from Siskiyou Gap. A line called the A-Line was started in the gap and run southwesterly to pick up the various water sources of Cow Creek.

The next portion of the work called the B-Line, was started from the same point in Siskiyou Gap and run with a descending slope of .002 to the proposed tunnel site.

effort was successful. Two days after the party had completed this preliminary work and returned to Ashland a heavy snow storm set in.

Camp was moved twice during the progress of the work, first to a point on McDonald Creek and next to the tunnel site at Split Rock. The return to Ashland was made Oct. 24.

place strong springs all over the hillside on both slopes. It is also entirely possible, if not strongly so. This, however, is only a hazard and can have no place in estimating the amount of water to be derived from the project.

Tunnels in the same granitic formation elsewhere indicates that in all probability little timbering or concrete will be necessary except at the portals.

The A-Line intercepted one large and six small branches of Cow Creek. Four water measurements were taken as representing the combined flow of these seven streams. In one instance three, and in another two, of these streams unite but a short distance below the A-Line as run. While there may possibly be a very slight increase in the volume of the water in this short distance the adoption of a slope of .001 in the final location of the line will put the points of diversion close to the points at which the measurements were taken, hence they are held to be representative.

Investigation of this and other important items pertaining to the project, relegated to the dim future because of the immediate expense involved on the easy going assumption that the city can be assured of securing this water at any time within the next ten or twenty years, is likely to prove expensive economy.

A sharp contrast should be drawn between a storage project, to which any development in Ashland canyon is necessarily limited, and a direct stream flow. The estimated cost of completing the Cow Creek project applied in the most advantageous way possible on any Ashland canyon development would secure only 650 acre feet of impounding. Such a reservoir could be filled and used but once in the average year. Should a considerable growth in the population and industry of Ashland ultimately force the one remaining resource of the canyon development, the direct flow these Cow Creek sources taken at low stage would fill such a reservoir in 65 days. This feature, taken alongside the fact that the combined resources for conserving or augmenting the water supply are narrowed to three, universal metering, canyon development and this Cow Creek source, should be given due weight.

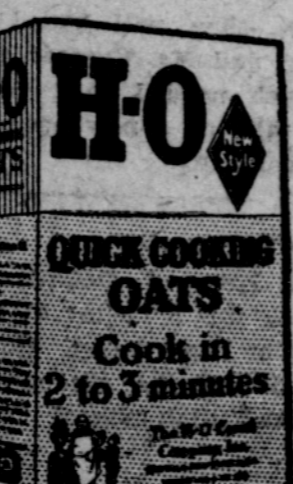
