REPORT IS MADE ON NEW NEWSPAPERS IN BUSINESS IN STATE

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON, Eugene, Feb. 4. — (Special) — Newspapers and magazines of general circulation are published in 134 communities of Oregon, according to the annual survey of the state press made by Prof. George S. Turnbull of the University of Oregon school of Journalism. The total number of periodical publications listed in Prof. Turnbull's directory of the Oregon press is 251, or approximately the same as in 1923, when the number was 253.

This year's total excludes all publications issued at educational institutions, but includes the various communities in Portland, of which there are 17. Only one of these was listed in the directory compiled last year. The addition of publications issued by educational institutions would send the total periodical publications past 300.

Prof. Turnbull's annual survey shows that two new daily papers were started in the state in the past year, the Central Oregon Press, at Bend, and the Klamath News, at Klamath Falls. Both of these advanced from twice-a-weeks, bringing the total number of dailies in Oregon to 33, an increase of two in the year, since there were no fatalities in this field.

New weekly papers totaled 8, exceeding by 1 the number of deaths in this field. One of the 7 weeklies that expired, however, was a paper printed in a nearby town of larger size, and one was an exclusively farm news paper, reducing to 5 the total number of actual home-town weeklies that failed.

In the twice-a-week and weekly field no paper is counted which is a part of a daily newspaper. Thus the reduction of twice-a-weeks from 7 to 4 is not a loss of independent twice-a-weeks, which have held their own at 4, with the additions of the Cottage Grove Sentinel and the St. Helens Mist to the number, counterbalancing the loss of the Bend and Klamath Publications that moved to the daily class.

Nineteen Oregon papers reported change of ownership during the year as compared with 23 in the preceding twelve-month period. Two more changes in editors-in-chief, however, are reported, with 29 as against 27.

Women appear to be holding their own, approximately, in the editorial and publishing ends of the newspapers, with 11 women editors and 7 women publishers reported. Lack of detailed re-

TEACHES RADIO BY PHONOGRAPH

WASHINGTON, Feb. 4. — The use of phonograph records for teaching telegraphy and radio to soldier students has just been put into effect successfully by Captain John P. Ferriter, in charge of telegraph practice in the Army Signal School at Camp Alfred Vail, N. J., it was announced at the War Department today.

The method has been in use for some time in teaching languages, and, also, to some extent in teaching telegraph code; but Captain Ferriter has improved the method with excellent results.

It has long been a recognized fact that in learning the code the student is handicapped if he associates the idea of dots and dashes with letters of the alphabet instead of only the sound of the dots and dashes. For this reason messenger boys who grow up in telegraph offices usually make the best and fastest operators, as they learn the sound of the letters rather than the characters which stand for the letters.

At Camp Vail the new system is for a first-class operator to send letters and numerals, which are recorded directly upon a wax phonograph record. These records are then used on a phonograph, so that the student hears the sounds representing letters always correctly sent, and at such a speed and for such a length of time as desired.

The student is always taught to receive letters before he attempts to send. After once learning to receive correctly by the sound of the letters it is a very simple matter for him to send, and speed is only a matter of practice.

10,000 MACCABEES TO INVADE CAPITAL

DETROIT, Mich., Feb. 5. — Friendly relations between the United States and Canada will be commented by the Maccabees' international automobile caravan, bringing 10,000 members of the order of both nations to Washington next Summer, according to A. W. Erve, supreme commander.

"More than 2,500 automobiles from every State in the Union and every province in Canada will take part in the procession next July," said Mr. Erve. "A good percentage of the Maccabees' 220,000 members are Canadians. By driving to our national capital and fraternizing with United States members they will carry home with them a new appreciation of American ideals."

"The Maccabees' caravan will be the largest tourist movement by automobiles ever organized in North America. Mobilized in a column two abreast, the automobiles could enter Washington in a procession ten miles long. Automobiles making the trip will use approximately 400,000 gallons of gasoline. The caravan will consume more than \$1,000,000 worth of food while in Washington."
