BRITONS COMING FOR TRACK MEET

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 20.—The joint track teams of Oxford and Cambridge universities will journey to this country and will appear in meets with Harvard, Yale, Princeton and Cornell.

The English athletes will meet the combined teams of Harvard and Yale at the Harvard stadium, and the following week they will meet Princeton and Cornell, probably in or near New York.

The exact dates of the meets have as yet not been determined, but it is believed the meet with Harvard and Yale will come early in July. The time depends on the dates of their final examinations, which have not yet been announced.

It is expected that the events to be contested will be the same as those at the last meet between Oxford and Cambridge and Harvard and Yale, held at Wembley in July, 1923.

These were twelve in number, as follows: Flat races: 100 yards, 220 yards, 440 yards, 880 yards, one mile and two miles. Hurdle races: 120 yards, high; 220 yards, low.
