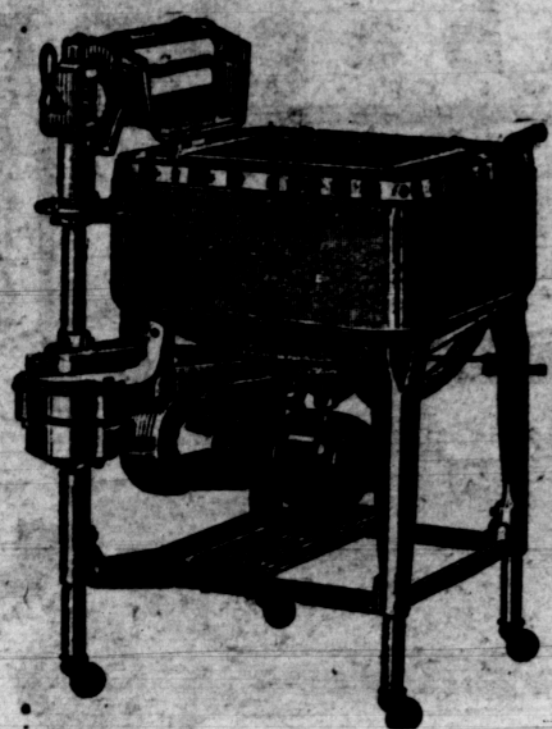

EASTMAN REVIVES ANCIENT DANCING

ROCHESTER, N. Y.—The aesthetic ideal of life held by the ancient Greeks, but long lost in the shuffle of modern civilization, may come into its own again in the new Eastman School of the Dance and Dramatic Action, formed as a part of the University of Rochester, is successful in its aims.

Rouben Mamoulian, formerly connected with the Moscow Art Theatre, is the moving spirit in the new school, which owes its being to George Eastman, kodak manufacturer and noted philanthropist, who has given millions to education.

Not only will the school provide courses in professional dancing, but it will aim to include the dance as a vital part in general university education, ranking with mathematics and philosophy.

The idea underlying the school is unique for this age, Mamoulian says, but it is really very old. It embodies the Greek conception of life as ruled by

rhythm and grace, with rules and commandments given lesser stress. By the practice of this ideal, according to the school director, character and self control are gained and habits are formed of universal value to health and citizenship.

Mamoulian hopes to reunite the two muses of the dance and the drama, which were well nigh inseparable in Greek life.

Ostriches to Race Horses in Vienna

VIENNA — Ostriches racing against horses will be seen at the race track here shortly.

The ostriches are being brought here by their Italian trainer, Signor Meloni, who promises to mount jockeys on the birds and rack them under the same conditions as the horses. They are said to run faster than any trotting horse, but, owing to their obstinacy, are not to be relied upon to run straight and true.
