#### AMERICAN INTEREST IN PHILIPPINES

East is East and West is West is just as true of mat ters of political control, as it is in most other human problems. George H. Fairchild, editor of the Manila Times and a representative of the American class in the Far East that believes firmly in the right of the Occident to rule the Orient because whites are better than yellows, in the current number of the American Review of Reviews makes fun of the "intelligentzia" in Asia. He says that the noise they make is out of all proportion to their number or authority and that the rising tide of color has been stimulated by the pens of American and European writers.




