WHY HARNESS SUCH AN INDUSTRY

The railroads of our country represent a total investment of over 21 billion dollars, and are owned by nearly a million of our citizens, a large per cent of whom are employees of the company in which they own stock

The railroads pay annually over \$300,000,000 in taxes, and in some states they pay as much as 40 per cent of all tax income

Railroads purchased last year 26 per cent of all bituminous coal produced, 5 per cent of all anthracite, 27.1-2 per cent of total steel output, and 1-4 of all lumber produced in the United States

Statistics show that each inhabitant continues to require the movement of more freight. At the present rate of increase, we must enlarge our transportation facilities nearly 50 per cent by 1930, if they are to be adequate for our needs
