It disposes of a purported estate of \$2,500,000, representing the spoils of a lifetime in "The Wolf's" rise from southern grocery clerk to a master's degree in crooked finance.

"The world may call him 'Wolf,' but I shall always call him Dad—and love him," says Alice. "He is innocent of any crime, and I shall fight the world for him, since he no longer can fight for himself."
