SCOLDING JURIES

And while we are speaking of the duties of officers why should it be thought smart for a judge to "roast

Nothing gets a thrill more in a courtroom than for the judge to rise up in his righteous wrath and tell 12 men what he thinks of them, after they have brought in a verdict that he disapproves of.

But it makes one feel like telling the judge to "Take come one of your size."

In fact, the judge has no more right to "roast" the jury than the members of the jury have to "roast" the indge. Each judge and juryman, in his private capacity in a man with rights of self defense and none whatever of offense. And in their official capacity, the duties of each are strictly defined by statute. The law does not provide that a judge may scold the members of the jury for disagreeing with his personal opinions about the case. The law in certain cases permits the judge to set aside a verdict. It does not provide that he shall quarrel with it, or quarrel with those who bring it in.

What would kappen if a juryman arose in his place and declared, either as a citizen or as a member of the jury, that he thought the conduct of the judge quite outrageous.

Why should not something of the same thing happen vhen the judge outrages his own dignity, and that of the court, by denouncing the members of a jury, whom he has sworn to bring in a verdict in accordance with the facts? And this judge has had during the course of the trial, most arbitrary and despotic power to see tha tthe facts are presented to the jurymen as he, the judge, may see

BUILDING THEIR OWN SYSTEM

While we are giving this Italian dictator his due, it should also be noticed that, in the course of his tyranny he is creating another "home-rule" feature of Italian in

He is building up a system of industrial soviet that includes both owners and employers. For this he is condemned by the socialists and the communists. His labor union system is government controlled, and it takes into consideration the interests of the owners as well as of the workers. For this it is anathematized by those who recard in theory the interests of none but the workmen. In ractice neither Mussolini in Italy nor Rykov in Russia s concerned primarily with the nterests of the workman. Sech is first concerned with his own political structure. Museolini started-out as a socialist. He found that som did not work to suit him. So he built up the seist structure. But the value of the Mussolini system of industrial organization is that it makes Italy indeadent of Russian interference, or from interference from any other part of the world. It makes it Italian. If the system goes to pieces, it will fail probably first all because the tyranny of the government has alien-

ated too greatly popular sympathy. But at least it should be said for this rule that it is nsive to focal Italian conditions, rather than benade, as the previous socialist administration of Italy was, a catspaw for the Russian soviet propaganda.
