SCOLDING JURIES: And while we are speaking of the duties of officers, why should it be thought smart for a judge to "roast" jurymen?

Nothing gets a thrill more in a courtroom than for the judge to rise up in his righteous wrath and tell 12 men what he thinks of them, after they have brought in a verdict that he disapproves of.

In fact, the judge has no more right to "roast" the jury than the members of the jury have to "roast" the judge. Each judge and jurymen, in his private capacity, is a man with rights of self defense and none whatever of offense.

What would happen if a jurymen arose in his place and declared, either as a citizen or as a member of the jury, that he thought the conduct of the judge quite outrageous.

Why should not something of the same thing happen when the judge outrages his own dignity, and that of the court, by denouncing the members of a jury, whom he has sworn to bring in a verdict in accordance with the facts?

BUILDING THEIR OWN SYSTEM: While we are giving this Italian dictator his due, it should also be noticed that, in the course of his tyranny he is creating another "home-rule" feature of Italian industry.

He is building up a system of industrial soviet that includes both owners and employers. For this he is condemned by the socialists and the communists.

Each is first concerned with his own political structure. Mussolini started out as a socialist. He found that socialism did not work to suit him.

If the system goes to pieces, it will fail probably first of all because the tyranny of the government has alienated too greatly popular sympathy.

But at least it should be said for this rule that it is responsive to local Italian conditions, rather than being made, as the previous socialist administration of Italy was, a catspaw for the Russian soviet propaganda.

KEEP BIRDS WORKING FOR US: Experts, reports Popular Mechanics, find that a plague of caterpillars, in a London park, is due to the fact that the birds have become lazy.

The people who visit the park feed the birds. They no longer have to work for a living. When the birds were hungry, they kept busy with the insects. They devoured the eggs, and the stock of caterpillars was kept down.

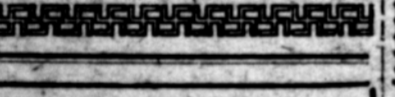
