STEWART'S WASHINGTON LETTER

WASHINGTON — Is Senator Burton K. Wheeler being persecuted?

A good many of his brother senators are going to make up their minds affirmatively unless the government makes out a stronger case against him at his coming trial here than it made against him in Montana, on the charge of having acted as "fixer" at the Interior Department for Gordon Campbell, the oil man. At least that's the consensus of gossip around the capitol now.

Persecuting a senator, in other senators' eyes, is about the worst offense imaginable. Senators are something like royalty. Kings may quarrel between themselves, but let the populace rise up against any particular king and all the other kings are on his side.

Their feeling is that an institution of which they're a part is being attacked. What weakens or overthrows one king threatens the whole kingly system.

Plenty of senators disliked Senator Wheeler's investigation of the justice department. When he was indicted some of them may have hoped the government had adequate grounds for it.
