today report that troops of the
Christian general, Feng Yuh Siang
have entered the city of Tien Tsin
from the South, after cutting the
railway lines to Nanjing and
Peking.

General Li Ching Ling forces
were reported to be retreating to-
ward Tien Tsin, and the casual-
ties on both sides were said to
have been extremely heavy.

LEADERS AGREE UPON
SEREVA ARMS TRUCE
WASHINGTON, Dec. 22 - (U.
P.) - Congressional leaders are
in agreement with President
Coolidge's decision to accept the
League of Nations invitation
for American participation in
the preliminary negotiations for
the Geneva arms conference. It
was made plain today by Sen-
ator Borah, republican of Idaho,
chairman of the Senate foreign
relations committee. He was dis-
cussing the matter after a con-
ference with Coolidge and Sec-
retary of State Kellogg.

TIDAL WAVE RUINS
AN ENTIRE ISLAND
HONOLULU, Dec. 23 - (UP) -
A special Tokio message to the
Hawaii Hochi Chu today reported
that the island of Yap has been
devastated by a series of tidal
waves, believed to have been
caused by earthquakes under the
ocean. "The entire island has
been laid waste, with not one
house remaining standing," the
advice stated. Grave fears were
also felt for the Carolines, be-
lieved to be in the path of the
tidal wave.
