Women to Meet for Vocational Study Feb. 16

ST. LOUIS, Jan. 10—(V. F.)—The exploitation of successful ventures by women into vocational, educational, professional, art and scientific fields, will be the object of the Women's National Exposition, Congress of Women and Gallery of Notable Women, historical and contemporary, which will bring America's womanhood to this city February 16 to 22.

At the exhibition, which will be held West of the Mississippi river for the first time, there will be more than 50 women farmers and agriculturists represented. They will exhibit prize cattle, sheep, swine and horses.

Mrs. Mabel Walker Willebrandt, Assistant United States Attorney General, will be the outstanding speaker at the Women's Congress although many others equally as prominent will appear before other branches of the triumvirate organizations. The exhibition "for, of and

by women," is for the purpose of introducing to members of the sex the accomplishments of her sisters in other fields of endeavor.

While exhibition space will be sold the exposition is not to be conducted for profit; any surplus receipts going to reimburse those who have under-written the expenses of the affair.

Should there be a profit above this amount it would be donated to institutions for the betterment of women and children.

"The woman who excels in homestead needle work will have an opportunity to discuss conditions with the female manufacturer of ladies' ready-to-wear, or myriad other industries, the edification of both," declared Mrs. Louis J. Brooks, executive secretary of the Women's National Exposition.

"The exposition is arousing the interest of women in all walks of life and is receiving hearty cooperation," she declared.
