lians, who were later arrested. Predatory animals include 640 ovotes, 485 wildcats, 35 mounain lions, and 24 wolves. Bounties for the extermination of the above are offered.

Fur bearing animals are made up as follows: Beaver, 240; fox, 448; martin, 900; mink, 740; badgers, 67; ermine, 270; skunk, 150; muskrat, 10.

Hunters are estimated have killed 350 blacktail deer and 12 bear during the past open season. A total of 89 coyotes, five mountain lions, 49 bobcats and five wolves are also said to have been killed.
