JEWES NEEDED TO HUSTLE US CLAIMS FORD

NEW YORK, Jan. 27.—(U.P.)—Henry Ford feels that in the past he may have been too severe in his criticisms of the Jews, according to an interview with the major magazine that appeared in the February issue of the magazine Farm and Fireside Monday.

What I oppose most in the international Jewish money power is that it is not in every war, said Ford in the interview. "No matter what happens to the nations in a war the money power always wins. No war starts without it and every war stops when it says so. That is what I oppose—a power that has no country and that can crush the young men of all countries out to death."
