THE HIGHWAY TO LIFE
Millions Now Living Will Never Die

At the Winter Garden Memorial Hall yesterday at 3 P. M., Mr. W. T. Thors of New York, one of the lecturers of the International Bible Students Association, presented evidence from the Bible to show that the way to everlasting life on earth is now being made ready. He said in part: Our text is found in Isaiah 42:16. It reads: "Go through, go through the gates, prepare ye the way of the people: cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people."

The advent of the automobile brought with it the superb concrete "unfenced boulevards" which now traverse the country from end to end. The states vie with one another to see which shall have the best highways and thus attract the motorists. Hence, we live in a day when the construction of "superior highways is a very familiar sight."

The highways which men are constructing for purposes of automobile traffic are important. They make possible the full development of millions of acres of food-producing lands which are now partly or wholly idle. They are part and parcel of God's arrangements for distributing food to the billions of humanity who will shortly come forth from their graves in obedience to the Savior's promise, in St. John's gospel, the fifth chapter, the 28th and 29th verses: "For the hour is coming in which all that are in their graves shall hear his voice, and shall come forth."

But important as are these national roadways which are being designed by our highway engineers and built with consummate skill, the highway mentioned in our text is still of greater importance. It is the highway of life, the way over which we pass to the human family, after being awakened from the sleep of death, may come back into full harmony with God, and obtain the reward of that harmony in the blessing of everlasting life here on earth.

Notice the way the same prophet puts this matter in the same chapter in which he tells us that "the wilderness, and the solitary place, shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as a rose," and "in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert; and the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water."—Isaiah 35:1-7.

TRAPPING FUR IN SISKIYOU
Open Winter Hits Mountaineers Here; Trappers' Bounty Helps

YREKA, Calif., Feb. 2.—With an open winter with little snow or cold on even the highest ranges, trapping in Siskiyou has been a dismal failure this season and many trappers who have collected several hundred dollars worth of furs in past seasons are gathering in their traps.

The coyote bounty has helped out several of the more active trappers and in other seasons have not had the individual bounty to help them on their campaign of extermination. Following the payment of the bounty, the pelts are sold to fur dealers, the prices ranging from 15 to 25 and this season's pelts have not commanded the top price, owing to the lightness of the fur.

Mink, skunk, raccoon, rinstail and other furs that are taken by trappers in every part of Siskiyou have not been caught in large numbers this season, the open weather giving them so much food they paid little or no attention to bait. Those that were caught gave pelts of inferior quality. Trappers in the vicinity of Mt. Eddy and Mt. Shasta have started to gather their traps and the Salmon mountain and Klamath river trappers have also almost given up hope for a profitable season.
