**WOMEN RUN  
MEN FROM WORK  
SAYS LEADER**

There is one thing that  
Gary believes that partially  
plains his success as a  
leader. It is this: "The work-  
ing man has more brains than  
he is given credit for."

It is this faith that has en-  
abled the men under him to be-  
come profit sharers and stock-  
holders. He believes that em-  
ployees are good employees  
and will make a good prod-  
uct. A man who believes that  
does not need to fear com-  
petitors. His policy toward them  
is: Produce a good article at a  
fair price and competition will  
take care of itself.

Honesty is the quality that  
Judge Gary esteems highest in  
an employee; then he puts cour-  
age; then persistence; then, ef-  
ficiency.

"The foundation of business  
success is character," he says,  
and continues:

"If you have it, your word  
will be as good as a United  
States government bond. J.  
Pierpont Morgan had character.  
He valued it in others above  
anything else. When a man  
wanted to borrow money from  
him, he paid more attention to  
that man's character and repu-  
tation than to any collateral of-  
fered as security. Marshall  
Field, the 'Merchant Prince of  
Chicago,' had character. Abra-  
ham Lincoln had it to a supreme  
degree, and from it came the  
reputation for honesty that  
lifted him above every unjust ac-  
cusation his enemies could  
make."

Judge Gary declares that in  
his youth he had to overcome  
an inherent indolence. "In  
plain English," he says, "I was  
inclined to be lazy. I had to  
fight indolence with ambition."

Judge Gary's rules for suc-  
cess, given in response to a di-  
rect question are:

"I used to know an old fiddle.  
The gist of it was: 'Don't try to  
be what you ain't.' That's  
sound. Hitch your kite to a  
star, but don't throw it at a  
star. Be methodical. Take one  
step after another. Don't try  
to stride up five steps at once—  
you may slip. Make a hard-  
headed estimate of what's in  
you, then move forward evenly,  
unhurriedly, but without stop-
