SACRAMENTO, March 2—The widening and straightening of the Picific Highway through the Sacramento canyon will be continued during 1924. This was announced here today by State Highway Engineer R. M. Morton, who has been authorised by the highway commission to prepare plans and specifications and advertise for hids for the grading of 4.58 miles of the highway from Dog Greek to Lamoine, in Shasta County. Negotiations for rights of way, it is expected, will be concluded in the immediate future. The work will be financed from gaseline tax funds.

Including two bridges, have been completed or maced under way. Ten miles of concrete bavement have been finished, eighteen miles of primary grading has been done, and thirty-four miles of graded highway peconstructed. The estimated cost of work completed or now under way is \$2,133,000. This represents expenditures by the present commission on this important interstat connection.
