**Leaders In Scout Activity Convene With County Head**

Cecil A. Cook, the Scout Executive of Jackson and Josephine counties, and Mr. Hayward, Regional Executive of the Scout movement with headquarters at Spokane, met with a group of Ashland men at the Plaza Cafe last night during the supper hour for the purpose of discussing Ashland's relation to the supervision of the Scout work here and the part which should be borne by Ashland in the budget for that work. Mr. Cook lives in Medford but gives a good share of his time for the development of new troops, training of scoutmasters, etc., in the other cities of the valley from Grants Pass south. There are two Scout troops in Ashland, one of which has been in operation for about twelve years, and the other about seven years. It is thought that some plan can be worked out so as to coordinate the Scout work with the boy's work already being done here under the leadership of the local Y. M. C. A. and make both more effective. Since the Association was organized here with a secretary on part time basis, the Scouts have been included in the "Y" work and the secretary has been able to assist materially in the enlistment and training of the boys. The average scoutmaster cannot find all the time necessary to do all that is necessary to keep things moving. Mr. Cook met with the American Legion recently and was given assurance of their support to the Scouts. The group which met with the Scout officials last night was composed of the Legion scout committee, the scout troop committee, the executive committee of the Y. M. C. A. and the local scoutmasters.

**FOREIGN PROTESTS PILE UP IN TOKYO**

TOKYO, March 6—(U. P.)—While the foreign office and officials are still reading the very lengthy report of the police on the incident wherein the Ambassador from Brazil is accused of having beaten up a policeman with his cane, fresh diplomatic complications are piling up. From the Soviet Embassy has come an informal protest against the ruling of the chief of police that the playing of the Russian national air—the Internationale—is not allowed, except at the Embassy. The Mexican minister has filed a strong protest against the paying of the Mexican national air—La Paloma—as a musical accompaniment for Charlie Chaplin's latest movie, the Gold Rush. As every one in Japan knows La Paloma, while very few know that it is the Mexican anthem, the protest considerably surprised the movie people, but they hastily agreed to eliminate the tune hereafter. The third protest was filed by the German Embassy against the captions on an American movie, claimed to be anti-German, which was being shown at the Imperial Theatre. On the strength of the protest the censor got busy with his shears, and Imperial Theatre patrons had to do their own guessing as to what the picture was about, with many of the captions deleted.

**THIS LILY DOES NOT NEED SOIL OR WATER**

NEWCASTLE, Pa., March 6—(U. P.)—Defying all laws of nature, science, gravitation, or what have you, a bower blooming from a bulb which has neither soil, nor roots, and which is not supplied with water, is being shown to visitors at the home of Rev. A. M. Stump here.

**GERMAN AIR BOUQE TO REACH PACIFIC**

MOSCOW, March 6—(U. P.)—The world's record for long distance commercial flying will be established when the Aero-Lloyd, a German aviation company, and the German-Russian stock company start their contemplated airplane service from Berlin to Vladivostok. The company plans to cover this distance of approximately six thousand miles within fifty hours by day and night flights in fast planes. The first lap in the journey, from Berlin to Moscow, will be covered in one night. The passengers will change planes in Moscow. Other bases for the trip are being organized in Omsk and Irkutsk.
