Trout have started spawning in Diamond lake and a special crew will be placed on the scene this week to begin the 1926 egg taking operations, according to report received by M. L. Ryckman, superintendent of game fish hatcheries, from Lloyd Wilson, head of the Diamond lake operations. Wilson made a trip to Diamond lake last week and reported that there is only three or four feet of snow on the summit and less than two feet at the lake. The ice on the lake was about ready to break and the first spawning fish were entering tributary streams. The Diamond lake station is the most important station in the United States. Last year more than 17,000,000 eggs were taken during the spring operations. Medford Mail Tribune.
